Goal 1, Section 1.1, "Have all government agencies declare themselves to be agencies where all government officials do not Accept gifts and all kinds of gifts from performing duties (No Gift Policy)"

In this regard, in order to drive reform activities according to the national reform plan above, create transparency within the agency. Create values in performing duties and should practice it as a culture of honesty in the municipality Tha Wang Tan Subdistrict Therefore, it is announced to all executives, employees, officials, and personnel in the organization not to accept gifts and items. All kinds of gifts from the performance of duties (No Gift Policy) every festival and special occasion, unless necessary and unavoidable, must follow the rules for receiving gifts or presents. and any other benefits as Regulations of the Office of the Prime Minister on Giving or Receiving Gifts by Government Officials, B.E. 2001, together with the National Anti-Corruption Commission Announcement on Criteria for Receiving Property or Any other benefits provided by the Code of Ethics of Government Officials, B.E. 2020

therefore, it has been announced for everyone to know. and for all executives, officers, and personnel under their jurisdiction to hold Continue to strictly follow the policy.
